Tentative Itinerary

- July 7 Fly from the U.S. to Johannesburg, South Africa
- July 8 Explore Johannesburg (and the Apartheid Museum, time permitting)
- July 9 Travel to Botswana and go on an Open Safari Game Drive in the Khama Rhino Sanctuary
- July 10 Travel to Maun, the gateway to the Okavango Delta
- July 11 Pole down the river in a Mokoro – a dugout canoe – steered by a local “poler” and experience the African heartlands
- July 12 Sunrise walk, keeping an eye out for Elephants and Cape Buffalo. Day to explore, swim, and canoe
- July 13 Return by Mokoro to Maun and visit a local rural village
- July 14 Travel to Nata and visit the stunning Makgadikgadi Salt Pans
- July 15 Head to Chobe National Park, Botswana’s first national park best known for its high concentration of Elephants
- July 16 Full day to explore Chobe National Park, keeping an eye and an ear out for trumpeting Elephants, chuckling Baboons, roaring Lions and many other exiting animals.
- July 17 Travel to Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe and have lunch on the banks of the Zambezi River.
- July 18 Full day Whitewater Rafting trip down the Zambezi
- July 19 Begin travel back to the U.S.
- July 20 Arrive back in the U.S.
