### **Program Options**

#### Team Building, Zany Group Games, and Field Games

From buddy walkers, spider webs, 80's group fitness, to "toxic waste" and gutter ball, our team building initiatives, debriefing sessions, and zany games are built to foster connections, confidence, problem solving skills, decision making, open communication and more! Our field game rotations give the chance for kids to be kids as they jump, run, laugh, leap and play together.

#### **Portable Obstacle Course**

Our portable obstacle course helps students challenge themselves, take safe risks, cheer each other on, and have a blast during a year when kids need extra chances to be kids and have fun.

#### **Wetland Ecology**

Migrate like a flock of geese, develop a stronger sense of environmental stewardship, touch and smell real biomass from the wetland, and uncover fascinating functions of marshes, swamps, and bogs!

#### **Forest Ecology**

A true adventure as participants discover the interconnected world of plants, animals, and soil, as well as understanding the role each plays in maintaining a healthy forest ecosystem.

#### **Animal Adaptations**

The term adaptation describes the concept that certain animals have selective features which help them survive in their given habitat. Participants will explore habitats and play games that simulate the concept of adaptation.

#### Survival Experiences

Give students hands-on experience filled with orienteering, traditional camping skills, fire building\*/outdoor cooking\*, and backpacking know-how. (\*Optional based on school fire building policies)

#### **Engineering for Success**

Putting a STEM twist on Camp Henry Team Building, participants are split into small groups and encouraged to accomplish tasks using simple materials such as paper, cardboard, tape, etc. These initiatives foster communication, collaboration, creativity, engineering, resourcefulness, and thinking outside the box.

#### **Arts & Crafts**

Participants have ample opportunities to creatively express themselves with any of our uniquely curated projects.
