

CURRENT COVID-19 POLICIES

March 2021

Camp Henry will follow all social distancing and safety protocols required from local and state government agencies.

Food Service

In order to keep our guests/campers safe during meal times, we will be demonstrating the "cafeteria style" food service style. Before joining the line, guests/campers will be asked to wash their hands. After hand washing, guests/campers can go up to the kitchen windows and receive a plate from our food service staff. A "Grab and Go" meal style may also be used.

Lodging

The number of guests/campers that can stay in the same lodging will depend on local and state health guidelines. Lodging spaces are arranged to allow for at least 6 feet of separation between guests/campers. Common areas like bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized daily. Each overnight group will have their own unique and designated bathroom.

Programming

Camp Henry staff will follow local and state guidelines and will be social distancing while working with guests/campers. Hand sanitizer will be available in every building and at every program area. The program staff will also be monitoring the sanitation of supplies, and will sanitize supplies in between groups. Programs and activities will be scheduled outside or in open air settings whenever possible.

Temperature & Symptom Checks

Upon arrival, Camp Henry staff will be temperature checking and symptom screening all guests/campers. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 and/or COVID symptoms will not be allowed to participate and will be removed from camp.

Face Coverings

Guests will be asked to bring a face covering with them to camp. Face coverings will need to be worn while in the food service line, or if they are in close proximity to another group. While participating in outdoor activities, face coverings are suggested, but not required.

Transportation

Guests/campers who will be utilizing our transportation service will need to be temperature checked and symptom screened before getting onto a Camp Henry van/bus. Face coverings will need to be worn while on a Camp Henry van/bus.
