



## PERU ADVENTURE JULY 5<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026

Join Camp Henry for this **once in a lifetime trip to Peru!!!** We will fly into Lima, Peru and take two weeks to travel to the Amazon Jungle, to hike the Inca Trail to Machu Picchu, to experience a homestay on Lake Titicaca and sample the best that Peru has to offer.

- **Stay in an eco-lodge in the Amazon Jungle and travel the river, keeping an eye out for jaguars, anacondas, howler monkeys and caimans**
- **Spend 4 days hiking the 26 mile Inca Trail with jaw dropping views and reaching elevations of over 13,750 ft.**
- **Visit Machu Picchu, one of the famed Seven Wonders of the World**
- **Stay with a local family on the shores of Lake Titicaca**
- **Visit local communities and rub shoulders with the inhabitants of the Sacred Valley – and if we are lucky our visit might fall on market day, where we can pick up some hand painted beads or a warm poncho**

Jake will be leading this trip. In addition to being Camp Henry's Director, he has led countless Adventure Travel excursions throughout the world. We will be partnering with local guides and experts throughout our entire trip. Airfare, most (27) meals, ground transportation, 3 domestic flights within Peru, excursion fares, tipping, and all fees included. Campers will want some spending money for souvenirs, snacks, and meals not included.

**Trip Price: \$4,950 \*based on airfare estimate. Price & dates will be confirmed by 10/31/2025.**

We may adjust the dates by a day or two in order to secure the best rates on airfare. We will be flying out of Grand Rapids, Chicago, or Detroit.

Priority registration for graduating seniors (Class of 2026), ages 17-19. If space is available, class of 2027 campers that will be at least 17 years old at the time of the trip may be added to the trip.

This trip involves strenuous physical activity including hiking the mountainous Inca Trail at high elevations. Participants will need to be physically fit and excited to hike and explore. This trip is NOT for casual tourists.

The goal is to have a fairly balanced number of males and females on this trip.

| July 12 | Day 2 of Hiking the Inca Trail – going over Dead Woman's Pass at 13,828 ft and camping in the Pacaymayo Valley at 11,000 ft <b>T</b>  |
| July 13 | Day 3 of Hiking the Inca Trail – going over 2 mountain passes and down to Winay Wayna and camping at 8,366 ft <b>T</b>  |
| July 14 | Day 4 of Hiking the Inca Trail – up at 4:30 am to be at the Sun Gate at 6:00 am. Arrive at Machu Picchu and go on a guided tour, then descend on the bus down to Aguas Calientes for lunch and then board the train to Ollantaytambo and finally a bus back to Cusco <b>H</b> |
| July 15 | Day to rest and relax and explore Cusco <b>H</b>  |
| July 16 | Bus from Cusco to Puno, the gateway to Lake Titicaca <b>H</b>   |
| July 17 | Boat Tour of Lake Titicaca followed by a village homestay <b>V</b>  |
| July 18 | Breakfast with host family, then back to Puno for the night <b>H</b>  |
| July 19 | Fly from Puno to Lima, with our farewell dinner in Lima <b>H</b>  |
| July 20 | Travel from Lima, Peru back to the U.S. <b>T</b>  |
